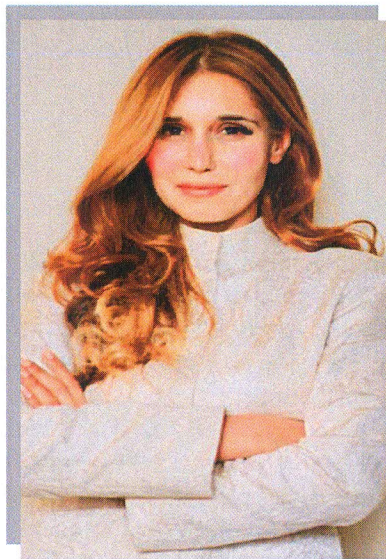

Ms. Fakhar completed her education from University of Cambridge, UK in 1998, specializing in Trade and Investment laws and policy. Having working at Clifford Chance world's largest law firm in London and at the WTO in Geneva; she launched her first venture MAP Services Group. MAP initially kicked off as a boutique trade and Investment advisory for Governments and Multinationals, based out of Geneva. Ms. Fakhar's vision and exposure in the Gulf countries enabled MAP to diversify into a private equity focusing on raising investments and designing Government funds. In addition she is engaged in her family business of Rice exports.

**Social Activist:**

Ms. Fakhar is a passionate social worker. In 2006 she authored Pakistan's White Revolution called Doodh darya in Urdu. As Board member of Nestle Pakistan's DRDF rural and farmer development she has influenced 500,000 dairy farmers primarily women. She also runs Pakistan's Food Bank for the poorest providing food supplies to more than 10,000 needy people. She has also been appointed as an Honorary advisor to HM King Charles III's development Organization for promotion in Pakistan, wherein they support 3,000 schools and more than 300 orphanages across Pakistan. Ms Fakhar is also a sponsor of the Circularity Fund that invests in sustainable and circular business models across the supply chain especially in the food sector.

Ms Fakhar the Founder of the Pakistan Malaysia Businesswomen Forum. She has served as Chairperson for Medium Businesses Pakistan Business Council's India Pakistan Business Council.
